

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR TEACHER CANDIDACY

All Education Majors who wish to pursue an education degree must complete the requirements below to be considered for **Teacher Candidacy**:

#4	Online Teacher Candidacy Application	Teacher Candidacy Online Application  https://ycp.co1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_6M8A CGr1p2qrTUx	Requirements #1 - #4 must be scanned and available for upload into the online Teacher Candidacy application prior to starting the application.  Scanners are available in the YCP library, if needed (free for student use).

## **Contingent Teacher Candidacy:**

Education Majors may be considered for **Contingent Teacher Candidacy** if Requirement #1 is the ONLY requirement the student is waiting to fulfill and is in need of registering for Teacher Candidacy courses. <u>All other requirements must be met.</u> The contingent applicant will use the same online Teacher Candidacy application as noted above. See below for exceptions to Requirement #1 that may be utilized for contingent status:

- The student has a reasonable prediction that he she will possess a 3.0 or better at the end of the current semester AND
- The student will have 48 completed credits on their transcript at the end of the current semester AND
- o The student will have achieved a 3.0 or better on the above 6 specified courses

If the above conditions are not achieved at grade posting, Contingent Teacher Candidacy is revoked and the student must drop all Teacher Candidacy coursework from his/her schedule.
