Faculty Speaker *and* Recipient of the Presidential Award for Teaching and Mentoring Excellence

Dr. Paul J. Ackerman, Jr.



Dr. Paul J. Ackerman, Jr. is an Associate Professor in the Department of Civil and Mechanical Engineering. He received his B.S. in Civil Engineering from Virginia Military Institute, an M.S. in Civil Engineering from West Virginia University, and his Ph.D. in Civil Engineering from Virginia Tech. A registered professional engineer, he has over 20 years of experience in engineering, consulting, and project management across a variety of state and federal projects. Prior to teaching, he was part of the engineering team that assisted the Virginia Military Institute with the design and execution of a \$500 million capital projects program. He has also had the opportunity to assist with the design and construction of civil engineering service projects in Uganda, Bolivia, and Guatemala. His technical research focuses on construction management, construction materials, and engineering methods to improve construction feasibility and remediate design issues identified during construction.

At York College, Dr. Ackerman primarily teaches courses in construction and site design engineering. He enjoys introducing experiential learning in the classroom by utilizing actual construction projects and problems to increase student engagement and learning. Dr. Ackerman's pedagogical research includes collaborations with faculty and the civil engineering industry on several publications and presentations on evaluating student learning outcomes and improving student engagement. His most recent publication was a collaboration with senior civil engineering students to redesign the first-year civil engineering surveying lab based on current industry practices and the students' in-depth co-op experiences with site design companies. Dr. Ackerman enjoys mentoring and working with student organizations and is a faculty advisor for the College's student chapter of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE).

Dr. Ackerman attended the ASCE Excellence in Civil Engineering Education (ExCEED) Teaching Workshop in 2021. He is currently serving as co-chair of ASCE's Pennsylvania Infrastructure Report Card Committee. The committee includes 60 engineers and professionals tasked with evaluating and reporting on the condition of Pennsylvania's infrastructure in a school report card format to inform the public and policymakers about the state of assets such as roads, bridges, and water systems. Dr. Ackerman is honored to be the 2025 recipient of the York College Presidential Award for Teaching and Mentoring Excellence.

Academic Regalia

The medieval scholar wore a clerical robe so all would know his station in society. The clerical-type robe was appropriate, since all students were expected to become part of the clergy. Distinctions have always been made among the academic grades. Thus, the robe of the doctor is more elaborate than that of the master, and the master's is different than the undergraduate student.

Academic regalia has always consisted of three parts—the gown, the hood, and the cap. There is considerable variation in European universities. In 1893, a system was adopted in the United States so that one could tell at a glance the university where the degree was earned, the field of study in which the degree was earned, and the level of the earned degree.

Most robes are black, although occasionally a particular university may adopt a robe of another color, such as Harvard in adopting the crimson as its own. Doctoral robes are longer, fuller, and more richly trimmed, with bands of velvet down the front and on the sleeves. These can be black or symbolize a field of study. The master's gown has sleeves usually cut above the elbow and the bachelor's gown is a simple pleated robe.

The cap of most American universities is typically the stiff, square, black traditional mortarboard with black tassel. The doctoral cap may have a gold tassel, with the tassel worn on the left. Many European universities favor the soft beret-type cap, and a few American institutions use this type.

The hood is the most interesting and colorful part of the regalia. The largest hood is the doctor's, while the smallest is the bachelor's. The color, or colors, of the hood's lining, arranged in chevrons, symbolizes the colors of the college or university that granted the degree. Thus, York College of Pennsylvania has chevrons of green and white. The velvet trim, visible at the neck, indicates the field of study in which the degree was earned. Some frequently seen hood colors and the fields of study are as follows:

Golden yellow | Science
White | Arts and Letters
Light blue | Education

Pink | Music
Drab | Business
Apricot | Nursing

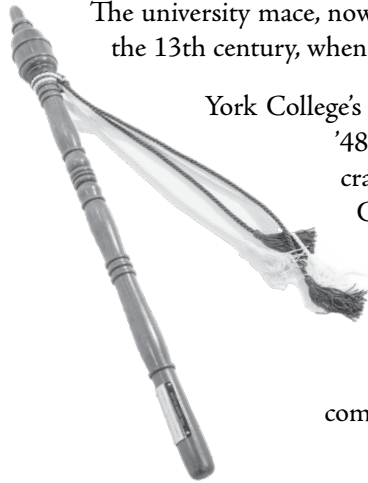
Scarlet | Theology

Seal



The York College seal was first shared on the cover of the March 1970 issue of *The York Scene*, the alumni publication at the time. That issue also offered an explanation of the seal's meaning: "The open book suggests the basic reason for the existence of York College—that the institution holds as its purpose the primacy of a good education. The green and white colors which make up the seal are variously reversed in contiguous areas. The motto, 'servire est vivere,' is translated as 'To serve is to live.' It states a basic axiom of that which the nobleman seeks. Certainly, service to mankind is that ideal to which society should attain, and without which society becomes self-seeking and individualistic and in effect, 'dies.' "

Mace



The university mace, now used during commencement and convocation ceremonies, traces its origins to the 13th century, when it was held by the protector of a sovereign at official meetings.

York College's official mace, carried by the Head Marshal, was created by Edward Glatfelter '48 and presented in 1961 to York Junior College President Dr. Ray Miller. It is crafted from two pieces of wood believed to have come from the buildings of the College's earliest predecessor institutions: York County Academy (founded in 1787) and York Collegiate Institute (founded in 1871).

The smaller black maces, carried by other Marshals during the procession, are the earliest versions of the College's academic mace and were first used during the 1959 commencement exercises. The tradition of leading the commencement procession with the College's mace has continued for over 50 years.
